ACE HOLDING YARD & CRAFT SALE TO BENEFIT VICTIMS OF HURRICANE KATRINA

Members of ACE (Association of Citizens Employees) Community Solutions, a non-profit corporation formed by Citizens' employees, will hold a Community Yard and Craft Sale on Saturday, October 8, 2005 from 7 a.m.- 2 p.m. The yard and craft sale will be held on the front lawn of the Citizens' business office, located at 220 Webbs Mills Road, on Route 8 in Floyd.

The community is invited to purchase 10x10 spaces for \$10 each to sell their personal yard sale and craft items. Money raised for space rental will be donated to Hurricane Katrina Relief.

ACE is also partnering with community organizations to distribute needed items to victims who are temporarily relocated in the community and surrounding areas. ACE will have a booth at the yard sale in which the public is welcomed to make monetary and item donations. All proceeds from the ACE booth will be disbursed to benefit victims of Hurricane Katrina through relief efforts to individuals and organizations that are actively providing temporary homes to hurricane victims. Any unsold items will be donated by ACE to participating hurricane relief organizations.

Anyone interested in donating items for yard sale should bring items to Citizens business office by October 7. No tax receipts will be given.

How can you support ACE in the hurricane relief efforts? (1) Reserve a \$10 space at the yard and craft sale to sell your own personal items and crafts, (2) support ACE efforts by donating items to be sold and donated to Hurricane Katrina victims, (3) shop on October 8th on your way to the Floyd Annual Arts & Crafts Festival, (4) make a monetary donation at the ACE booth.
